Summary:

- A total of 138 questionnaires were sent out, and 72 were returned, achieving a response rate of approximately 52.2%, an increase of about 7.3% compared to the previous year. In summary, parents' opinions on the Parent's Week and the Student Learning Report are as follows:
- This year's Parent Week involved parents from each academic level meeting with the class teacher at the school auditorium on a designated day.98.6% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the mode and arrangement of the Parent's Week in the first semester.
- Regarding student performance reports, in the primary and junior secondary groups,100% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Elementary Chinese, Elementary Mathematics, and General Studies;98.2% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Independent Living (Self-care) and Independent Living (Social Adaptation);100% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Independent Living (Perception) and Physical Education;98.2% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Music, Visual Arts, and Computer Studies;96.4% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Interest Groups;94.4% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Technology and Living; 89% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the learning content and summary of Design and Technology.
