**Summary:**

A total of 137 questionnaires were sent out, and 74 were returned, achieving a response rate of approximately 54%, an increase of about 1.8% compared to the previous year. In summary, parents' opinions on the Parent Week and the Student Learning Report are as follows:

- This year's 1st Term Parent Week involved parents meeting with the class teacher at school. 100% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the way and arrangement of 1st Term Parent Week.

- 98.6% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the content and summary of Resource Teacher for Autistic Children / Individual or Group Remedial Teaching in learning report; 100% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the content and summary of Resource Teacher for Non-Chinese Speaking Children in learning report; 95.9% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the content and summary of Speech Therapy in learning report; 96.8% of parents



were satisfied or very satisfied with the content and summary of Occupational Therapy in learning report.

- 97.3% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with diversified learning modes of students; 100% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with enough learning resources of students.
- Regarding Major concerns, 97.3% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that schools could help their children develop good moral character; 97.3% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that lectures and activities (such as: parents get close to nature, parent-child picnic and Lunar New Year orchid workshops, etc.) could promote cooperation between home and school and foster understanding and support for national education in schools.
- 96% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that teachers understood students' learning abilities and were able to adjust teaching methods to enhance students' learning interests; 97.3% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that the school's teaching model helped encourage students to participate in the learning process, students behaved confidently when participating in learning activities that are consistent with their abilities, and with appropriate support, students tried their best to complete their homework or exercises; 95.9% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that students could learn new things through appropriate media; 98.6% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that with appropriate support and guidance, students could live healthily; 96% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that the school's strategies, such as Library Classes, Reading Reward Programs, and Periodic Promotional Videos on the "Mo Fan Campus TV Station," could stimulate students' interest in reading.
